Rotary District 3080 Leadership Academy 2014

The 11th session of the Leadership Academy is scheduled to begin in October 2013 with the first of the six Rotary lessons and exercises set to be dispatched to the participants. The residential workshop is scheduled to be held in Chandigarh April 11 through 13, 2014. The venue will be announced shortly. The course fee for the session is fixed at Rs.14,000.00 per person which will include course material, Rotary lessons, all public meals and 3 days and 2 night stay on basis of boarding. The first installment of Rs. 7,000.00 is payable before September 30, 2013 and the second installment of Rs. 7,000.00 later by March 15, 2014. If spouses are accompanying the participants the extra payable for the entire duration will be Rs. 6,000.00 per person. The spouses will be able to attend the classes as observers without participating in the activities. Participants will be provided double occupancy air conditioned rooms during the residential programme. All payments are to be made by way of DD drawn in favour of Rotary District 3080 Leadership Academy payable at Chandigarh. Rotary District Headquarters, 107A, Sector 16A, Chandigarh.

At every stage of our lives and our careers, Rotary has something for all of us - a way to lead us to do more, be more, and give more. Rotary gives us life, more meaning, more purpose, and greater satisfaction. And the more we give through Rotary, the more Rotary gives back to us in return.

Dear Fellow Rotarians,

I am sure that all the clubs of the District would have had the 'installation ceremony' of the current year's Presidents and their teams by now. I have been receiving the reports that the clubs observed austerity in these functions and have contributed the savings of the expenses towards the Unwarthand Disaster Relief Fund, currently being maintained in the Rotary 3080 Service account. I am thankful to the clubs to have honored the call for the low key installations.

I have to share with you that Rotarians from even other RI Districts have been remitting contributions besides sending relief materials. In the second week of August two loads of Food grains - 'wheat flour' - were generously brought and taken to Urorhathi and Bahadurganj by Rotarians from Gujrat. I also thank Rotarians from our District who have, mostly through their clubs, contributed generously towards the 'Unwarthand Relief Fund' and the 'Jawan Relief Fund'. A recent news item of the middle aged and senior citizens of those affected by the Kosi river flooding of 2008 travelling on foot and collecting even small amounts towards the relief fund to repay the debt, symbolically, to those who had helped them in need should be inspiring enough for all of us to reach out our brothers in need.

We have, as on date, crossed the forty five days mark of the current year which brings us into the 'Membership Development' month. Please adopt the SWOT (Strength, weakness, opportunity and threat) test of your club and make sincere endeavours in inducting good members while ensuring the retention of the existing ones. A fine balance of quantity and quality should ensure that the clubs move onto a progressively increasing numbers of members. Senior members must mentor the new members and involve them in all the Rotary activities to ensure healthy and effective clubs.

This month 'blood donation' projects should be taken up to ensure that our targeted figure of 25,000 units are collected. Against the projected need of 8 to 10% of the population donating blood in India, only about 2% donate blood. It is one of the best ways to ensure that we care for and help out on the life giving and life saving gesture to enable our fellow human beings to come out of emergencies.

My official visits to the various clubs in the month of July 2013 were very encouraging. I could, first hand, observe the seriousness with which our clubs function. And these clubs have done a good job in the running of vocational centres including a tailoring unit in a village. A public library has been running successfully, even in these days of electronic media commonly finding all information to every one on all the diverse topics. The clubs that I visited are Rotary Club Kaithal, Rotary Club Saharanpur, Rotary Club Rohtak and Rotary Club Gangoh. These clubs have also unfolded their goals for the year and have chalked out strategies in implementing them.

The Intensity on Membership Development, 'Visitat' had to be postponed due to the weather. Good pending increasing rains. It shall now be held on September 29, 2013. The current Registrations shall remain valid. Please encourage maximum number of Rotarians to witness, first hand, the warm hospitality that Rotary Club Saharanpur Greater has extended will greet the delegates. I also urge you to be part of 'Visitat' and I request all Presidents to send registrations in R.I. to Rotary Club of Chandigarh also take it to be a part of the ongoing RI President Ron Burton theme, 'Engage Rotary Change Lives'.
